# DUST CURTAINS

---

### ■ FUNCTION

The curtains are fitted in line with each wall or partition passage (anti-drop curtains at desks, anti-intrusion curtains) as well as perpendicular to the anti-intrusion tunnels.

They cover the entire communication bay between the two zones.

They provide insulation from air currents and act as a sound barrier between the luggage tunnel and the passenger area. They are also considered as an opaque and flexible form of separation when passing through the partition separating the luggage tunnel and the passenger area.

Thanks to their flexible nature, the straps are raised to the baggage transit area and immediately resume their shape without deforming with aging.

The curtains installed in line with the anti-drop curtains at the check-in desks are fitted downstream of the bay (collector side) of the partition, set back behind the curtain, with side panels guiding the straps and masking the view of the equipment located in the collection area (black painted sheet metal cladding).

### ■ CHARACTERISTICS

Each strap curtain includes :

- ◆ a series of interchangeable blades 60 mm wide. These blades are placed offset in double rows,
- ◆ a metal upper part holds the blades together and mounts the assembly onto the designated supports.

The mounting is by means of a metal strip with hooks which the curtain blade eyelets rest on.

The metal strip is easily removable to replace the straps.

Depending on the size of the bay and the characteristics of the conveyors, the straps are cut to fit the configuration.
